Cenatiempo Vini d'Ischia Forastera 2013, Ischia Bianco DOC, Italy

Humberto Canale Estate Malbec, Patagonia, Argentina £29.75

How God intended malbec to taste; Lashings of dark, spicy, perfumed elegance.

Ondarre Rioja Reserva, Rioja, Spain £32

A classic Spanish beauty; perfumed wild strawberries, cherries and a touch of balsamic spice from the oak; the wine exudes sophistication and allure. Go on, give in!

Carrick Unravalled Pinot Noir 2014, Central Otago, New Zealand £35.75

A soft, juicy cherry filled wine with soft silky tannins.

Rene Monnier Bourgogne Rouge 2013, Burgundy, France £40

Red burgundy is either gorgeous or heartbreakingly disappointing. This is the former. Perfumed, elegant and complex with crunchy cranberry and subtle earthy notes.

BriO de Cantenac Brown 2012, Margaux, Bordeaux, France £65

The second wine of Cantenac Brown, dark, rich and delicious, a modern take on Bordeaux from a stellar vinatage.

Chateau Pichon Longueville 2eme Cru Classe 2001, Pauillac, Bordeaux, France £153

Long considered a 'super second' this is a great wine from a quality vintage. It combines complex notes of graphite, leather and smoky tobacco with dark berry spice and rich mushroom notes. All of this achieved with effortless elegance, freshness and poise. Sometimes a wine really does deserve a pompous tasting note!

Biferno Rosso Riserva DOC Palladino, Molise, Italy £6.7 £17.5 £25.5

From the oft-forgotten and wild Molise region, this exceptional rosso over-delivers with a bouquet is complex and intense with hints of blackberry jam. On the palate the wine is velvety and harmonious with pleasant, firm tannins.
